Semester 1 Wrap-Up Information

Following Superintendent Borgfjord's recent email to all BGSD families, please note the following details specific to NSCHS:

- The last day of regular classes for all NSCHS students will be **Tuesday, January 27th**.
- No midterm or final exams will take place for Junior or Senior High students this semester. Teachers will enter an "**excused**" mark in the final exam and midterm category, if applicable, of each student's Semester 1 final report card to ensure grading consistency in PowerSchool.
- There will be no classes for all NSCHS students on Wednesday, January 28th and Thursday, January 29th.

These two days are set aside for students who need additional time to complete coursework required for course credit. Teachers may reach out directly to invite students to attend for specific support or make-up work during that time. Otherwise, students do not attend school on those days.

Semester 2/Quarter 3 will begin on **Monday, February 2nd**. Thank you for your continued partnership and support as we wrap up the first half of the school year!
