### APPEAL PROCEDURES FOR MARKS, CREDITS, REPORT CARDS

Diploma examination appeals are made via direct contact with Alberta Education after July 17, 2026.

Please be aware that **students outside the NSCHS designated catchment area may not be accepted** and that registration will be confirmed following a meeting with school administration.

### RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2025-2026 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2026-2027 are automatically registered for the 2026-2027 school year.

**All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2025-2026 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.**
